Monty Halls

Broadcaster, Writer, Presenter and Producer

Monty has presented twelve television series in the last fifteen years, for both terrestrial and satellite channels.

He is particularly well known as a wildlife and adventure presenter, although his background as a Royal Marine Commando has also meant a growing market for work as a spokesman for military charities and organisations.

Following the success of returning BBC2 series such as "Monty Halls Great Escape", "The Great Hebridean Escape", and "The Great Irish Escape", Monty went on to present the blue chip series "Great Barrier Reef".

His latest series for the BBC - "The Fisherman's Apprentice" - saw him work as a Cornish crab fisherman for six months. This series was described as:

"A blueprint for how television programmes should be presented" by Points of View.

Since then he has devised and filmed two other series - one for Channel 5, and one for Discovery - both about adventure and exploration.

His average viewing figures for BBC2 are 1.7 million, with consistently high A.I's. When "Great Escapes" was aired in the Sunday evening slot, it hit figures of 2.7 million (180% of the slot average), whilst Great Barrier Reef hit 3.3 million - also well above the slot average.

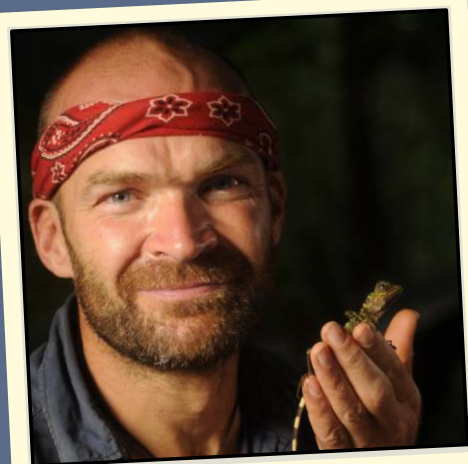
He has won two international awards for presenting, was nominated for a presenter Panda at Wildscreen, and Dive Mysteries and was nominated for the Donald Gosling Award at the Maritime Media Awards. His informed, measured, and light touch as a presenter has garnered a following that consistently ensures healthy viewing figures both in the UK and overseas. His background as a biologist, a travel writer of note, and an expedition leader and ex Royal Marine, also ensure credibility and authenticity.
